Acceptance of 'Letters of Credence' of His Excellency Dr. Yuba Raj Khatiwada, Ambassador of Nepal to the United States of America by His Excellency Joseph R. Biden, Jr., the President of the United States of America

Letters of Credence of His Excellency Dr. Yuba Raj Khatiwada, Ambassador of Nepal to the United States of America, was accepted by His Excellency Joseph R. Biden, the President of the United States of America on February 17, 2021.

Submitting his Letters of Credence to the White House through the Department of State, Ambassador Khatiwada addressed a 'remark' to the President. In his remark, the Ambassador conveyed the best wishes and warm felicitations of the Right Honorable President, the Right Honorable Prime Minister and the people of Nepal for the President's successful tenure, good health and happiness, and for the continued prosperity of the United States of America and its people. Furthermore, the Ambassador thanked the President for the continued support of the United States in the overall development efforts of Nepal, and expressed his firm belief that the multi-faceted relations between the two countries will further deepen and expand in the days ahead.

Acknowledging the receipt of the Letters of Credence of Ambassador Khatiwada, the President welcomed the Ambassador as a member of the diplomatic corps in Washington D.C. and expressed his Government's desire to further strengthen the abiding friendship between the two countries through advancement of the common agenda.

Owing to the COVID-19 pandemic restrictions, the mode of presentation of credentials was by paper, instead of the customary in-person ceremony.
